# **Synopsis**

Set in the early 1980s, *Bedside Manners* is a hilarious comedy filled with improbable dizzying situations. With a mild adult theme, this show has been called "witty, clever, and splendidly funny" by critics around the world. When Ferris reluctantly agreed to look after his sister's remote country inn while she was on vacation, he did not anticipate all the wild comings and goings involving her guests! Over the course of his house-sitting, Ferris becomes engulfed in lies, confusion, and bewilderment as he tries to prevent the inevitable meetings of husbands, wives, and lovers in assorted comical and unlikely situations.

### Meet the Cast

**Troy Greenawalt** (Roger) – Troy first appeared on stage as Frank Butler in the 2014 musical production of *Annie Get Your Gun*. He also performed as Yessel in *Fiddler on the Roof*, Scrooge's nephew, Fred, in *A Christmas Carol*, and Big Jule in *Guys and Dolls*. Dinner theater patrons will also remember him as Justin in *Fox on the Fairway*, Simon in *The Game's Afoot*, and as Alexander Puddington in *Murder at the Prop Table*. Troy is excited to play Roger in this production especially since he gets to fool around with Sally played by his beautiful wife, Michele.

Matt Godissart (Ferris) - Matt has been involved with the players for over 25 years! From his first part in *The Wizard of Oz* to some of his most recent achievements (among them, Robert in last season's *Boeing Boeing*, Cogsworth in *Beauty and the Beast*, and Jeremy Troy in *Here Lies Jeremy Troy*), Matt is thrilled to bring Ferris to the stage in this production. Christopher Diehl (Geoff) - Christopher Diehl is a Bedford native whose acting credits include Nick Carraway from *The Great Gatsby*, Sparky from *Forever Plaid*, and Sam Wainwright in *It's a Wonderful Life*. He is also involved in the Bedford music scene and Bedford County Library Outreach Program. He recently became a father to his beautiful daughter, Frankie (purr, purr, purr).

Michele Greenawalt (Sally) – Michele started performing with BCP in the 2014 production of *Annie Get Your Gun*. Since then, she has performed as part of the cast in *A Christmas Carol, Fiddler on the Roof, Guys and Dolls* and *Nunsense: The Mega Musical*. She also took part in dinner theater productions including Louise in *Fox on the Fairway*, Daria Chase in *The Game's Afoot*, and Jane in *Murder at the Prop Table*. Michele says," I am blessed to be performing once again, especially with this entertaining and talented cast. It is always a treat to perform with my husband, Troy. I hope you enjoy the show as much as I enjoyed performing as Sally."

# **Technical Crew**

**Noah April** (Light Operator) – Noah is a Sophomore at Chestnut Ridge where he is a member of the art club. Noah first performed on stage with his brothers in the BCP production of *Guys and Dolls*, many years ago. This is Noah's fourth show with the Players as part of the tech crew.

Susan Buttermark (Stage Manager, Costumer) – Sue was last seen as the crocodile in this season's *Peter Pan*. Other recent roles include Berthe in *Boeing, Boeing* and Sister Mary Wilhelm in *Nuncrackers*. She is a valued costume designer and dresser for the Players. Sue lives in Wiley Ford, WV with her husband, Bill.

Laura Price (Apprentice Costumer) — Laura first joined BCP as Liza, in this season's Peter Pan. She is from West Virginia and is currently living in the Frostburg area. Laura graduated from FSU with a degree in Botany. In her spare time, she enjoys reading, gardening, thrifting, singing in the church choir and learning more about costuming from Sue.

Nadine Glass (Props) - A veteran with our theater group since moving to Bedford. Her favorite role so far has been our Mother Superior in the Nunsense musicals. She is thankful that her children, Maggie and Amos, are living their dreams and sharing them with her. She has been involved on and off stage working on our dinner theaters, musicals, plays and cleaning, finding props and directing.
